The Summer School is organized by **fio.PSD** with the aim of supporting the Network Housing First Italy (NHFI) in the pathway to the comprehension and the implementation of housing first approach. The main goal of the Summer school is creating a starting point for members of NHFI based on shared principles and methods (*know and know how*) around the Housing first approach. Participation is reserved to members of NHFI.

The Summer school will take place in **Ragusa from 23 to 27 June** at the **Hotel Antico Convento dei Cappuccini, Viale Margherita**, <http://www.anticokonventoibla.it/>

Morning sessions will cover following **topics**: 1. Comparative perspective around the conceptual and theoretical framework of housing first (US, Canada and EU); 2. Ecology of well-being: the use of a perspective of community in Housing First; 3. Housing first, Mental Health and Social Care System; 4. Homelessness and House as living space. The sessions will provide a thoughtful overview of Housing First, covering the general principles of the approach, its structural dimensions, limits, opportunities, outcomes and processes. These and other aspects will be tackled through theoretically and empirically diversified approaches, therefore offering to the participants an overview of the methods, tools, and best practices that can be used to implement Housing First in their territories.

Participants will work in small **thematic based groups**. The selection will be based on choice of target involving in housing first programme. At the end of the Summer school every member of NHFI will be ready to start up a Housing first programme.
